












4 Finish drawing the remaining pictures in each row following the pattern in the first picture.













(8) Finish drawing the other half of the butterfly. You can use the same relaxing zentangle method or finish it at your pleasure.






10 Find four different nests and mark them with a cross, because baby birds could fall out of them. To the other nests, add birds' eggs or hatched baby birds, or even their mom.




spring snowflake.




 $\stackrel{\textstyle \textcircled{14}}{}$ Copy the butterflies into the bottom grid and give them bright colours.
