



 \bigodot Draw an animal around each pair of eyes. If it is too difficult for you, try to draw some little summer monsters.












③ Cut out and put together the sea jigsaw puzzle following the picture in the top right corner. You can also colour the pieces in and give them to somebody, so they can put them together, too.




4 Match the dots that are close together	. What two pictures can you see?




(6) Explore the maze and tell the pirate how to find the way to the treasure.






8 Finish the pictures – draw the other halves. Colour the pictures in.







 $\widehat{\ \ }$ Match the flowers with their names using a continuous line, but be careful not to damage the flowers. Colour the flowers in.




(1) Find out what picture is hidden among the lines. Take a red crayon to colour in the spaces with square signs, and a green crayon for the spaces with round signs.




12) Finish the pictures – draw the other halves. Colour in the lady bird with the right crayon and create some patterns on the wings of the butterfly.




